In accordance with Texas Administrative Code, Title 4, Part 1, Section 30.7 City of Tatum will hold a public hearing at 5:30 pm on June 12th at 680 Crystal Farms Rd. Tatum, TX 75691 regarding the submission of an application to the Texas Department of Agriculture for one or more Texas Community Development Block Grant Program (TxCDBG) grants for Program Years 2025-2026. City of Tatum may be eligible to participate in the Community Development Fund, the Colonia Fund Construction Program, and/or the Downtown Revitalization Program. The purpose of this meeting is to allow citizens an opportunity to discuss the citizen participation plan, the development of local housing and community development needs, the amount of TxCDBG funding available, all eligible TxCDBG activities, and the use of past TxCDBG funds.

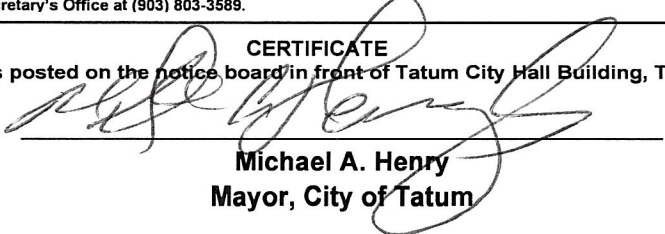

De acuerdo con el Código Administrativo de Texas, Título 4, Parte 1, Sección 30.7, la Ciudad de Tatum llevará a cabo una audiencia pública a las 5:30 pm on June 12th, en 680 Crystal Farms Rd. Tatum, TX 75691 con respecto a la presentación de una solicitud al Departamento de Agricultura de Texas para una o más subvenciones del Programa de Subvenciones en Bloque para el Desarrollo Comunitario de Texas (TxCDBG) para el Año Programático 2025-2026.
